This half term, Year 5 will be learning to . . .



Maths

This term we will be learning about data handling, averages in the form of mean, mode and median, 2-D and 3-D shapes and their properties, measurement and angles.

English

We are looking at recount texts currently and will go onto poetry later this term, which will be linked with some work we are completing jointly with Year 6 on Shakespeare. We will continue to work on our understanding and use of sentence structures and punctuation in sentences.

Science

This term we are looking at all 'Living Things'. What is needed to survive life on Earth by all plants and animals?

Personal, Social and Health Education

Our topic this term is 'New Beginnings'. This includes: learning to work together as a team and how to resolve differences of opinion within the team.

History

Our topic this term is Ancient Greece.

We will look at what life was like during this period and how its influences some of the things we do today.

We will also be dressing up like Ancient Greeks and holding an 'Ancient Greek Day' later in the term.

Religious Education

We are looking at the role of signs and symbols in religion and Hinduism.

Music

During this term we will be exploring rhythm and pulse in a variety of music genres.

Art/ Design Technology

We will be designing, making and painting our own 'Greek Urns'.

Computing

We will be investigating and designing our own simple computer programmes using J2E.
