French: This term, all children in years 3,4,5 and 6 will start to learn French.

Maths

We will be using the recent maths test and teaching to the gaps present in the students' knowledge. Topics covered:

Data Handling, Measurement and Shape and Space.

English

Reading - using inference and deduction to answer comprehension questions.

Writing - Use connectives to link paragraphs and build structure in stories.

Students will be reading a historical fiction text relating to WW2 and then writing an autobiography of the main characters account of the war.

Music

Listen to a range of music and find different sounds and their effect.

Learning about how we socialise the playground affects others. - Bullying and friendship.

Science

Animals including humans-

- Identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system, and describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood.
- Recognise the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way their bodies function.
- Describe the ways in which nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans.

To explore the ways rules are useful to individuals and groups to look at ways that various traditions have used rules to define good behaviour.

Art/ Design Technology

Improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including: drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of materials [for example, pencil, charcoal, paint, clay]

History/ Geography

History- World War Two.

Learning about how and why the major events of the world took place.

Multimedia and word processing.
