Varjak Paw will be the basis of our learning in Literacy this year and our overall aims are to


- To enjoy a story and discuss its meanings

- To compose a narrative written from another character's point of view






In <mark>Maths</mark> we will be learning...

About the place value of numbers and children will learn to develop an understanding of the number system, working with numbers beyond 10,000. Within this unit children will also learn about negative numbers and Roman numerals.

Addition and subtraction: The children will be learning to add and subtract numbers mentally and using written methods of calculation. They will also be learning to apply these skills to solve problems involving addition and subtraction.

Multiplication and division: The children will also be learning to recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12 × 12. They will be learning to use place value, known and derived facts to multiply and divide numbers using mental strategies and formal methods of calculation. In addition to this the children will be learning to solve problems involving multiplication and division and a combination of these, including understanding the meaning of the equals sign
