

What are we learning in Summer 1?



In **Communication, Language and Literacy** we will be learning...

- To explore the stories 'What the Ladybird Heard' and 'Bog Baby'
- To talk about the stories that we read.
- To make up our own stories.
- To join in class discussions and listen to others.
- To learn about traditional tales and join in with repeated refrains.
- To recognise and write our names.
- To use different tenses (e.g. play, playing, will play, played).
- To understand prepositions such as 'under', 'on top', 'behind'



In **Knowledge and Understanding of the World** we will be learning about...

- Animals that live on a farm
- Growth, decay and changes over time.
- Showing care and concern for living things

We will be growing vegetables in our garden and taking care of our new born chicks.

We will be visiting Hanwell Zoo to observe the animals.

In **Maths** we will be learning to...

- Count, write and order numbers to 10
- To recognise numbers to 10
- Separate a group of three or four objects in different ways, beginning to recognise that the total is still the same.
- To talk about shapes and use them to build models
- Talk about size and weight
- Order events and use positional language
