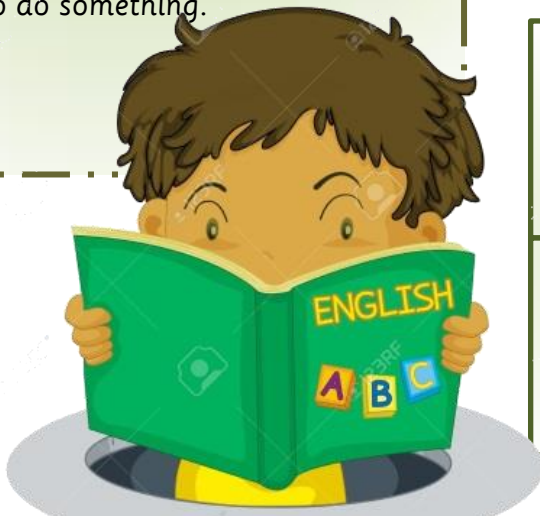


What are we learning in Summer 1?



In **Communication, Language and Literacy** we will be learning...

- To explore the stories 'What the Ladybird Heard' and 'Bog Baby'
- To talk about the stories that we read.
- To make up our own stories, tell them to others and put our ideas on paper.
- To join in class discussions, listen to others and to ask 'How?' and 'Why?' questions.
- To use different tenses (e.g. play, playing, will play, played).
- To follow and give instructions involving two or more steps.
- To write simple sentences about the places we have visited, keep diaries and write simple instructions about how to do something.



In **Knowledge and Understanding of the World** we will be learning about...

- Animals that live on a farm
- Growth, decay and changes over time.
- Showing care and concern for living things.

We will be growing vegetables in our garden and taking care of our new born chicks.

We will be visiting Hanwell Zoo to observe the animals.

In **Maths** we will be learning to...

- Add and subtract two single digit numbers
- Learn about doubling, halving numbers and quantities.
- Explore ways of sharing quantities and numbers.
- Use everyday language to talk about size and weight, time and money.
- Record our mathematical ideas and interests through mark making.



In **Creative Development** we will be learning to ...

- Experiment with mixing colours
- Explore the use of different textures.
- Design and make models using different materials to express our ideas.
- Perform a variety of songs and rhymes and make up our own songs.
- Use technology such as the interactive whiteboard for creative expression.
- Make up our own dance routines.



In **Physical Development** we will be learning...

- To ride trikes and balance bikes
- To handle balls and other sports equipment by pushing, patting, throwing, catching and kicking.
- How our bodies feel when we exercise and the importance of exercise for good health.
- To improve our letter and number formation.
- To use scissors to cut paper and malleable materials to make models.

In **PSED** we will be learning...

- We will be learning how to use the school behaviour system to get ready for Year 1
- To share and take turns and understand what is fair and unfair.
- To talk about the importance of honesty.
- To be kind to our friends
- To manage our feelings
- To know when to change our behaviour to suit different situations.
