In **English** we will be learning about...

Through these texts we will:

Non-fiction

Research our topic and write a non-chronological report. Look at the different types of non-chronological reports and their features. Look at how to create an email, invitation and post cards.

Stories and settings (Through our class texts)

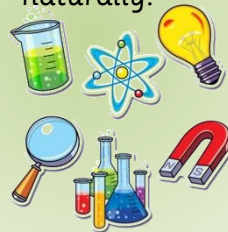
Explore how events in the plot are used in our power of reading texts and create characters by adapting ideas about the typical characters. Use different types of punctuation such as question marks, commas and apostrophes. Learn how to spell homophones and common exception words. We will look at the different types of letters and how and when we use letters in everyday life. We will look at informal and formal letters and learning when it is appropriate to use them and how they should look. We will also be looking at play scripts and how they are laid out and written. Then we will be writing our own and performing them to an audience.



In **Science** we will be learning...

Use of everyday materials

We will be learning about the different types of materials and how some are man-made and some are formed naturally.



We will be investigating how some materials can change over time.

In **Maths** we will be learning...

Measurement

- Choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length/height in any direction (m/cm); mass (kg/g); temperature (°C); capacity (litres/ml) to the nearest appropriate unit, using rulers, scales, thermometers and measuring vessels
- Compare and order lengths, mass, volume/capacity and record the results using $>$, $<$ and $=$.
- Tell time to the nearest 5 minutes, know the days of the week and months of the year.

Position and direction

- To recognise the positioning of objects from under, above, over and next too. Traveling forward, back, left and right.

Addition and subtraction

- To recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100.
- To use the place value of numbers to help such as Hundreds, Tens and Ones.

In **our Creative Curriculum** we will be learning...

Events beyond living memory.

We will focus on the Great Plague and the Great fire of London. As part of this topic we will be plotting events on a timeline and recognise how lives in the past are different to our lives now. We will look at a range of resources and source material and begin to learn how artefacts can tell us things about the past.

In **RE** we will be learning...

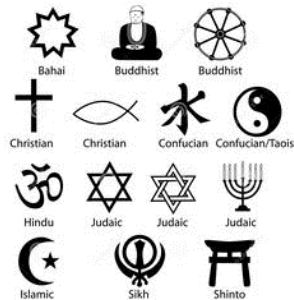
Our World: Caring for new life
