In **Maths** we will be preparing for our SATs.

Develop strategies to solve mathematical problems which involve all 4 operations.

After the SATs, Year 6 will focus on maths that will prepare them for the transition to high school.

They will complete a range of different investigations around data handling and apply the knowledge and strategies that they have learnt this year.



In **our Creative Curriculum** we will focus on our Year 6 Production.
