Homework

It is expected that your child completes their homework which will consolidate their learning in class.

Homework is given on Friday and handed in on Wednesday. If they DO NOT complete their homework or they do not hand it in out time, they will receive an amber on the behaviour system.

We will also have project based homework linked to class learning, which you can help them with.

Other

- No sweets or chocolates to celebrate birthdays please.
- Send your child to school with a healthy lunchbox, as we are now a SUGARSMART school.
- Party invitations should be handed out outside of class.
- No ball games or use of play equipment before or after school.
- Absence should be recorded in writing and handed to the office.
- Please ensure you inform the teacher/ office if someone different will be collecting your child at the end of the day.

Important notices

PE kits

Your child needs to have their PE kit in school on Monday and Wednesday for PE lessons.

If they DO NOT have their correct kit, they will not take part in the lesson for safety reasons and will receive an amber on the behaviour system.

For personal hygiene, we advise for PF kits are to be taken home. each week to be washed.

This is an example kit. In winter months, children should have warm black jogging bottoms/ leggings instead.



Hair

All long hair should be tied up for school each day, to reduce distractions and to keep them safe at playtimes, science and PE.

Water bottles

Please ensure your child has a water bottle (it is not recommended to use plastic bottles which are brought with water in them) Squash and flavoured water is not permitted in school. Please label your child's water bottle with a permanent marker.

Behaviour

At Woodlands Academy we have a Going for Green behaviour system and encourage children to stay on green by following the school rules and values. If your child stays on green for 35 days in a row they will receive a GOLD AWARD in assembly!

If they are not following school rules they will receive warnings, as below.

- First time: Verbal reminder will be given. The child still has time to think about the choices they have made.
 They still have an opportunity to stay on 'Green'
- . Second time: Second verbal warning will be recorded by an adult on the board.
- Third time: An 'Amber' will be recorded besides the child's name on the class behaviour log. They will be
 asked to move to the time-out area within their classroom to complete work and think about how what they
 could have done better. After a short reflective period they will re-join their group.
- Fourth time: A 'Red' will be recorded besides the child's name on the class behaviour log. They will be sent
 to have time out of class for the rest of the session with work to be completed.
