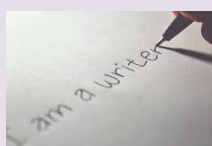

WRITING



- Create a leaflet explaining what Volcanoes, Earthquakes and Tsunamis are.
Don't forget to use:
 - Headings & subheadings
 - Images & captions
 - Key facts & opinions
 - Examples of famous volcanic eruptions (e.g Mount Vesuvius 79AD) and earthquakes/tsunamis (Indonesian 2004).

CRAFTS



- Make a collage of a volcano using different materials with labels of the different parts of the volcano.



- Make a 3D model of Pompeii as it was before the eruption. Think about the typical Roman buildings and Mount Vesuvius in the distance.



COMPUTING



- Make a PowerPoint on the Volcanoes/ Earthquakes/ both. It should outline what causes them and give examples of famous disasters and what happened.

You will present to the rest of the class using your PowerPoint. Please save your work on DB primary. Don't forget to use www.safesearchkids.com when researching!

How can an adult help me at home?
