<p>CRAFTS</p> 	<p>Make a model of an Iconic building/bridge which is on or near the River Thames. <i>Here are some you could choose from:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tower Bridge • London Eye • Houses of Parliament & Big Ben
<p>COMPUTING</p> 	<p>Make a PowerPoint on the River Thames. It should show how the river has changed over time. You will present to the rest of the class using your PowerPoint. Please save your work on DB primary. Don't forget to use www.safesearchkids.com when you are researching!</p>

What resources may I need?

Paper, pencil, colour pencils / felt-tips / crayons, card, glue, recycling such as cereal boxes, toilet rolls, boxes.
