IMPORTANT: REMINDERS

- If your child is having **difficulty** with their **homework** tasks, please **inform their class teacher before the deadline**. We cannot help with homework on the day that it is due in and children will receive an **amber or red** (Year 5 and 6) **for not completing it** before the deadline.
- Please ensure that you are **monitoring** your child's **access to the internet** at home. We have had several incidents recently where children have used **DB Primary** to send unacceptable or unnecessary messages, and some have been sent **after 10:00pm**. If your child is using DB Primary inappropriately, they risk having **restrictions** placed on their account, or their account being **blocked** altogether.
