2. A polar bear has thick fur and a layer of fat which keep them warm. In the desert it would be too hot for them to survive.

To start... Explain:

1. Why does this animal not belong in this biome?
2. What adaptations (changes) would it need to be able to survive?



This animal doesn't belong to this biome because the polar bear might die because it is too hot and dry. The polar bear needs a colder place to live. It also cannot live here because there is no food and you can notice the colour of the polar bear that it belongs to the arctic.

The things that would need to change is the climate. It needs to be cold and snow all over the desert and enough food for the polar bear but the desert animals would need to live opposite in the arctic.

The animals that live in the biomes are starting to get destroyed. This can be people cutting down trees. People cut down trees to make houses or to take wood to factories to make paper. But if we cut down trees, the animals won't have any food, habitat and they can die. When people cut down trees, under the soil, there are roots. Rain can wash away the roots or they can block the lakes and water. The roots can after start to block the water at the area can start to flood.



When we destroy trees there is going to be less wildlife and less fresh air for us to breathe. They keep on cutting down trees in the rainforest. The humans affect the biomes, the flora (plants), and the fauna (animals) that live there. Deforestation is the permanent removal of trees to make room for something besides forest. This can include clearing the land for agriculture or grazing, or using the timber for fuel construction or manufacturing. Forests cover more than 30% of the Earth's land surface, according to the World Wildlife Fund. We can reduce and prevent:

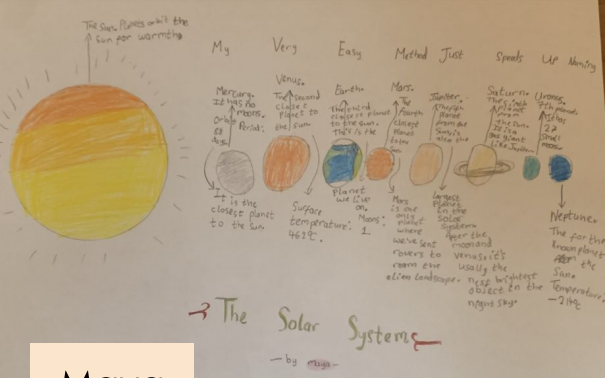
1. Plant a tree.
2. Use less paper.
3. Recycle paper and cardboard.
4. Use recycled products.
5. Buy only sustainable wood products.
6. Don't buy products containing palm oil.
7. Reduce meat consumption.
8. Do not burn firewood excessively.
