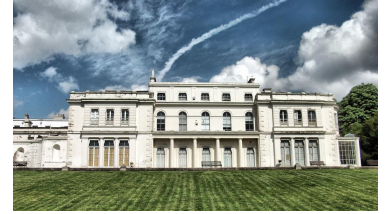

Dear Parents & Carers,

Re: Year 3 Stone Age Survival workshop, Gunnersbury Museum trip

As part of their learning about the Stone Age, Year 3 will be visiting **Gunnersbury Museum** on **Friday 1st October** for a **Stone Age Survival workshop**. During this outdoor learning experience 'pupils will discover the types of tools and materials used by Stone Age people. They will also be able to handle original and replica prehistoric artefacts from our museum collections. Outside in the park, they will identify sources of food and fuel, build shelters, try their hand at wattle and daub.'

We will leave school after the register at approximately 9:15am. We will be back to school in time for the end of the school day. We will be travelling on public transport, taking a bus to the museum. To cover the cost of the workshop, **we ask for a contribution of £5. Please put your money in an envelope with your child's name clearly labelled and ask your child to hand it to Miss Moxom.**

Please send your child to school in **a warm coat, their PE kit and school jumper** as it is an outdoor workshop. Please ensure they are also wearing **suitable shoes in case they get muddy**. Please provide a **healthy packed lunch** for your child, which can be brought in a small disposable bag. If you are entitled to **free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided** by the school kitchen on the day.
