Our exciting **Geography and Maths Fieldwork Week** is a week that encourages pupils to study their school grounds and/or local area. The week also focuses on the importance of fieldwork skills, such as measurement, sketching, questionnaires. These skills are closely cross curricular linked with the two subjects.

Our class will be travelling together to **Pitshanger Park - River Brent** on **Tuesday 28th June**. However, this trip is dependent on the weather. If it is raining we will postpone the trip to another date as the children will be working near a river which can get very slippery in wet conditions. The office will be able to let parents and carers know with a text. We will be leaving school at **1pm** and travelling by foot. We will return to school at approximately **2.30pm**. This is a free trip.

On the day of the visit, please ensure your child is dressed in the correct school uniform and has an **appropriate jacket or sun cream depending on the weather**. As we are working near a river, could you please make sure that your child is wearing **suitable footwear such as old trainers or wellies**. Please be aware that **there are not any toilets near where our fieldwork takes place** but we will try our best to be back at school within the hour.

Parents/carers are welcome to join us on the visit. Please let me know if you wish to join us. Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Adults will be notified of their success as soon as possible.
