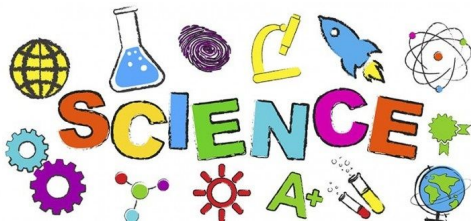




Year 4



For our Science topic, 'Living things and their habitats' we looked at invertebrates that we would find in our forest area. We then wrote about their characteristics.

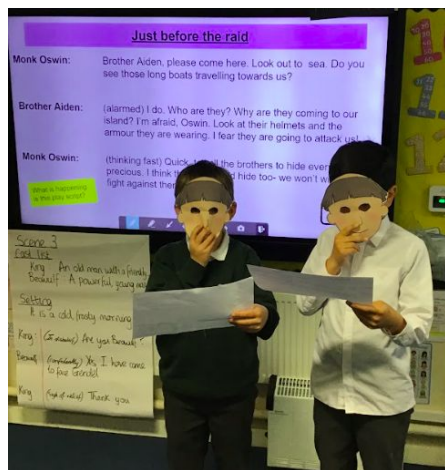

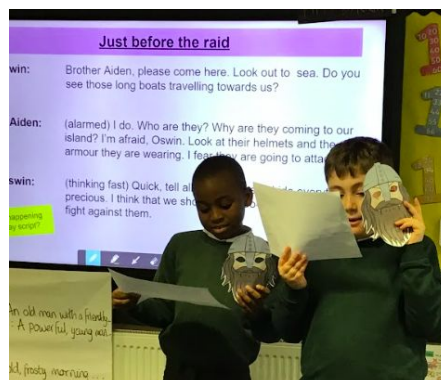
We also refurbished our Bug Hotel using recycled materials and materials from around the forest.



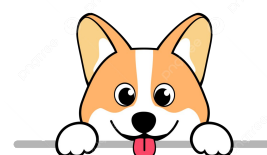
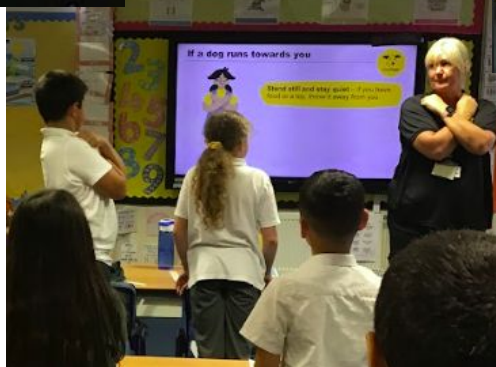


Year 4 continued...

During the workshop, we explored the famous river around the world. We learnt why they're important for for importing and exporting.

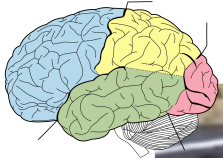
