
Golden Games

Next week is Anti-bullying Week. The Anti-Bullying Alliance defines bullying as: "the repetitive, intentional hurting of one person or group by another person or group, where the relationship involves an imbalance of power."

We will be celebrating Anti-bullying Week in a variety of ways.

This year's theme is MAKE A NOISE ABOUT

GREEN

My child seems happy and content. They like to go to school and have good relationships with other children and staff. My child is sometimes sad and can be reluctant to go to school. While they mention one or two friends, they seem to have regular fall outs with other children and have mentioned a number of situations where children have said or done unkind things to them, or they have said or done unkind things to other children. They seem unsure how to resolve these situations and I am not sure they are receiving enough help



RED

school or their usual activities. They do not see to have friends and I am concerned that other children often say or do unkind things to them They urgently need help to resolve the situation
