

#### Attendance below 90%

Some of families will have received letters about your child's attendance being below 90%. We hope to decrease the number of letters going out next half term so we appreciate your continuous support, to ensure that everyone is in school as much as possible (ideally every day).

#### **Morning gate:**

Pupils should arrive through the main playground gate between 8:30am and 8:45am. The gate will close at 8:45am. We have been holding to gate slightly longer in the morning to ensure that parents who have dropped their children in EYFS/ Year 1 are able to leave through the gates. However, please note, if you are bringing your child through the gate close to 8:45 am, you may be asked to be leave through the main building. A member of staff will escort you through the building.

This morning period is important in helping the children settle into the school day and teachers set Early Morning Work to complete.
