Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 1 will be visiting the Gunnersbury Museum **on Tuesday 28th January** as part of their History topic 'How toys have changed over 50 years'. They will participate in an active workshop '**Toys and Games of the past**'. **To cover the cost of the activities, we ask for a contribution of £5.50.**

We will be **leaving school at 9:10 am** and travelling by public transport to the venue. We will return to school by the end of the school day. If we are running late the school office will contact you.

As **all pupils are currently entitled to free school meals**, we require parents to pre- order these before the trip. This allows the kitchen to order and prepare the required number of packed lunches. **Please fill out the Google form by the date indicated if you want your child to be given a packed lunch and give consent for your child to attend the trip.** If you do not want a free school lunch to be provided, you must send your child to school with a **healthy packed lunch and a water bottle – NO GLASS BOTTLES OR FIZZY DRINKS PLEASE.**

On the day of the visit, please ensure your child is dressed in the correct school uniform and has **an appropriate coat or jacket**. If your child is not dressed in the correct school uniform, they may not be able to attend the trip. Also, please ensure that they are given the appropriate medication if they suffer from travel sickness.

Parents/carers are welcome to join us on the visit. Places will be selected at random. Adults will be notified of their success as soon as possible.
