## Payment options at the Book Fair

You have two options to pay for books at The Book Fair. The preferable and quickest method will be paying by card, using contactless. We will have a card machine for payment. However, you can also pay using cash.

Children attending sports clubs will be able to come to the book fair on a day when they do not have a club as it will be open for 3 days. If your child is attending **After School Care**, the member of staff in the office will be able to open the book fair for you when you collect your child.

If you can't attend the Book Fair in person, your child can order books via a Wish List – please speak to your child' class teacher if you would like to order books.
