Re: Y6 Residential Trip, 2026

Dear Parents/Carers,

The dates for the residential have now been confirmed. We will be travelling to the PGL Centre at Marchants Hill, Surrey from **Wednesday, 8th July to Friday, 10th July 2026.**

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

If you would like your child to attend this trip, it is extremely important that you attend all information sessions, complete all forms in accordance with deadlines and keep up with the payment plan.

The residential is a fantastic reward for pupils who work hard and demonstrate our school values as they approach the end of year 6; it is an opportunity to create lasting memories with their friends. Therefore, participation in this trip is dependent on behaviour and effort in learning and attendance. If pupils are unable to follow our school rules and values successfully at school, we are unable to take them on a residential trip where our staff will be responsible for them 24 hours a day.

A three strike rule operates in relation to behaviour and/or attendance. You will be notified if your child is given a strike and/or their place on the trip is at risk.

What will we be doing?

We will be staying at a designated site belonging to the company running our programme. Children will have all meals provided. The children will take part in a range of activities which could include archery, high ropes, abseiling or bushcraft and evening activities.

How and What do I pay?

The total cost of the trip for each child will be **£298** which includes full board and the activities. The school will pay for the cost of the coach. **A non-refundable payment of £40 is required to reserve a place for your child.** The remaining balance will be followed by 7 instalments outlined in the table below.

They will most certainly create memories with their friends that will last them a lifetime! We have experienced and dedicated staff attending who will be looking after your child, as well as qualified instructors who will run the activities.
