If it is their PE day they can continue to wear their PE kit on this day. Year 6 will have this special day on Thursday instead as they are on a school trip on Friday. If you are able to, you could also **contribute a small donation of 50p.**

We will also be holding a **pre-loved book sale after school** in the playground (weather permitting/ in the hall if it is raining). This year we are encouraging children at Woodlands to read more so please join us and choose from a selection of fantastic books for your children to read.

Money raised will be donated to the **Cystic Fibrosis Trust** who help people living with CF, a rare inherited genetic condition that causes breathing and digestive problems.

1 in 25 children – on average one child per classroom - has a genetic condition that makes their life very challenging. Jeans for Genes works with schools, companies and individuals all over the UK to help services and support for the children and their families affected by genetic conditions. Together, through fund and awareness raising, we can help make a real difference to their lives.
