
We will have a bake sale on Friday 28th November- 2:45pm in the hall.

3. Reporting Concerns

If you have any worries about a child's safety or wellbeing—your own or someone else's—please speak to a member of the safeguarding team immediately. We have been discussing the importance of giving others personal space so please reinforce this message at home.


