Thank you for your ongoing support with reading, homework, and ensuring strong attendance — it truly helps children thrive.


## Half Term Holidays




### Online Safety

Children may spend more time online during the holidays. Remind children never to share personal information or meet online contacts without a trusted adult present.

### Out and About

If children are spending more time outdoors or with friends, please ensure they know how to stay safe, where they are going, and when they are expected home. Younger children should be supervised appropriately, and older pupils should know how to contact you in an emergency.

### Wellbeing and Support
