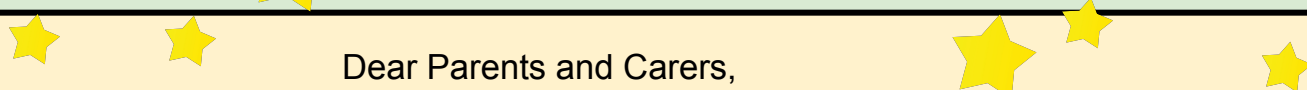

## Safety Reminders

To help keep our school community safe, we would like to remind everyone of a few important expectations:

- **Scooters and bikes should not be ridden in the playground.** Please ensure children dismount before entering the school grounds.
- **Mobile phones should not be used in the playground** during drop-off or collection so that adults can focus on supervising children and supporting a safe dismissal.
- Please remain **vigilant within our school community** and report anything suspicious or concerning to the school office or a member of staff.
- If you ever have **concerns about the safety or wellbeing of a child**, concerns can also be reported directly to ECIRS, which coordinates support from social care, health and police services to ensure children receive help quickly when needed. Call- 020 8825 8000 or if a child is in immediate danger, report it to the police by calling 999/

Thank you for your continued support in helping us keep all of our children safe.

**Operation Encompass-** we are working in collaboration with the Metropolitan Police Service as part of their legal commitments under Operation Encompass. 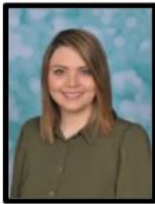
