Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 2 will be going on a local trip to visit the Sikh place of worship called a Gurdwara as part of their learning about Sikhism this half term. This trip will take place on **Monday 18th May 2026**.

We will be leaving school at **9:30am** and walking to the **Ealing Gurdwara**. We will return to school before 12 noon in order to have normal lunchtime arrangements.

On the day of the visit, we will be having a talk about some of the Sikh practices and tour of the Gurdwara. We will also be served Langar at the Gurdwara which will be a small, vegetarian meal or snack.

On the day of the visit, please ensure your child is dressed in the correct school uniform and has a bottle of water. As it is a Sikh place of worship, **all visitors should cover their heads with a scarf as a sign of respect for our sacred Guru. Please bring your own scarves to cover your head if at all possible.** If you do not have a scarf, there will be ones available to borrow at the Gurdwara.

- When you arrive, all visitors will remove their shoes and place them in the shoe racks and will cover their heads with a scarf. We cover our heads as a sign of respect for our sacred Guru.
- Please bring your own scarves to cover your head if at all possible. Hats & caps are strictly NOT worn inside a Gurdwara.
- Please also ensure that no outside food, alcohol, or tobacco products are brought to the Gurdwara in the belongings of students or adults including staff or parents.
