Dear Parents and Carers,

As you will be aware, extremely hot weather is predicted this week. I have carried out a risk assessment for this period and children have been spoken to in assembly this morning about the changes we will be making to cope with the weather.

Some classes, who get a particularly high amount of sun during the day, will be based in cooler rooms where possible. All pupils are encouraged to wear a sun hat and sun cream and to bring a water bottle to school. Additional cups will be provided by all sinks with drinking water to ensure all staff and pupils have access to water as needed.

If children are outside, they will be encouraged to use the shaded areas as much as possible. When it gets particularly hot (Tuesday- Thursday) we may have indoor play at lunchtime as it will be cooler inside than outside and running around in the midday sun is likely to be detrimental to the children's wellbeing. Where possible, PE lessons will be moved to the mornings when it is slightly cooler or held in the hall.

We will unfortunately have to cancel sports day on Thursday as 37°C temperatures are predicted for both Wednesday and Thursday and it would not be safe for the children to be outside doing energetic activities at this time. We are currently looking at whether another date is possible, but will try to check the weather in advance.

Given the high temperatures from **Tuesday- Thursday, if you would like to collect your children after lunch, online work can be provided for the afternoons.** Children can be collected from the school office from 1pm should you wish to do so. **School will remain open for any children not collected.**
